Mr. Lewis T. Ives, was born at Rochester, N. Y. on August 3rd, 1833, while yet an infant his parents bought a farm of eighty acres on the shores of Three-Mile Lake, near Pontiac, Michigan. Not finding farming in this region as profitable as was expected, his father, Eardly Ives, rented the farm and moved with his family to Detroit in 1838, where, with the exception of about three years in Canada when a mere lad, the remainder of his life was passed.

He was perhaps fifteen years old when he entered the studio of Fred Cohen, a well known portrait painter of his day, he remained with this teacher until the latter removed from this city two years later.

When about twenty years of age he and his brother James left for Europe the former for his health and to look after the young Lewis, the latter to pursue the study of his art. Their time was largely spent in London and Rome where he studied in the studie of famous American portrait painter, Wm. Page.

At the age of twenty-two he again returned to Detroit and shared a studio with Col. Chas. Lum, they remained together not more than a year, orders did not seem to warrant the maintenance of the studio, or even the continuance of the pursuit of art, so Mr. Ives turned his eyes towards some more profitable pursuit, law books were bought and he and his brother James again started on a journey, but this time to a small island, now called Welcome Island, in Three Mile Lake. There they built themselves a log hut of one room, about 10 x 10 feet, and for one year Lewis gave his entire time to the study of law. Their total expense for the year was thirty-six dollars, game and fish furnishing much of their food.

On his return to the City Mr. Ives entered, as a student, the law office of the late Judge Emmons where he remained about three years. Upon being admitted to the bar he entered the Detroit and Milwaukee R. R. legal department, where he remained for twelve years, working at law during the week and painting on Sundays, but the constant traveling and reading interfered with his health and eyesight and he resigned his position, and from 1872 to the time of his death Mr. Ives' entire time was given to his art.

During all his life Mr. Ives was devoted to literary pursuits, writing many articles for scientific and liberal religious papers. His life was full and active to the last, too active for his frail body and health.
