MRS. SAMANTHA L. HUNTLEY was born in Troy, N. Y.; studied at the Art Students League in New York, and in Paris with M. Jules LeFebvre, anatomy at the Ecole des Beaux Arts, and composition with Eugene Grassett. Spent a year in Spain, studying and copying Velasquez. For several years she was an instructor in the Emma Willard Art School of Troy, which position she resigned because her numerous commissions demanded all her time.

She has painted portraits of Governor Frank W. Higgins for the New York State Capitol, and other prominent people of her state; Governor Herbert S. Hadley of Missouri, Rt. Rev. John J. Glennon, Archbishop of St. Louis, and she has executed commissions in Madison, Wis., and St. Louis, Mo.

She has exhibited in the Boston Art Club, Society of American Artists, National Academy of Design, Albright Art Gallery at Buffalo, Wisconsin Historical and State Library, Albany Historical and Art Society, St. Louis Woman's Club, City Art Museum, St. Louis, Rowfant Club, Cleveland, in this country, and at the French Salon at Paris, and Royal Academy at London.
