ABSTRACT:	<p>Henry Carter Johnson was a painter and glass artist from Pentwater, Michigan. During the 1950s and 1960s, Johnson created miniature glass animals for tourists visiting Pentwater, working in the back of the local hardware store and calling his studio "The Glass Menagerie."</p> <p>This collection contains 1 CD-ROM of digital images depicting Johnson at work and with his creations, a photocopied price list, photocopies of newspaper and magazine articles, a 1957 issue of <i>Popular Mechanics</i> containing an article about Johnson, a photocopy of the 1953 studio's visitors register, and 2 framed photographic prints showing Johnson at work.</p>
