ABSTRACT: Collection consists primarily of 26 photographic prints showing the Tucker automobile in modeling and production stages; Preston Tucker selling a car to General Wainwright; and the final product on display at automobile shows and on State Street in Chicago, Illinois. Also included is a photo of the Tucker Torpedo Special with driver George Barringer at the Indianapolis Speedway. Images date circa 1946-1948. In addition to photographs, the collection contains car labels from auto shows; a Tucker article from a 1960 magazine; and an ad from the May 1963 issue of Motor Trend describing Ford Motor Company use of Tucker front wheel drive principles in the new Thunderbird.
