ABSTRACT: Joseph R. Grenier worked as a photographer for the Packard Motor Car Co. in Detroit, Michigan. This collection contains a large number of 8x10 black and white photographic prints and negatives documenting the Packard plant, automobile shows, assorted Packard automobiles including the Patrician and the Clipper, assorted automobile parts, testing in the plant and on the road, and firefighter drills performed at the plant. Also included are the December 1949 issue of the *Packard News*, 2 audiocassettes that contain an interview with Grenier made on 3 March 2003, 6 CD-ROMs containing digital images, and 1 unlabeled CD-ROM.
