ABSTRACT: Bruce Licher studied the letterpress printing process at the Women's Graphic Center in Los Angeles in 1982. Using these skills, he was able to create promotional materials and album packing for his band, Savage Republic, as well as other bands in the Los Angeles area. He later started Independent Project Press and Independent Project Records, both utilizing his letterpress skills to create artistic media packaging, stationery and cards, wine labels, book and magazine covers, and promotional postcards and posters.

This collection contains 5 holiday and celebration cards, one wine label, 4 stamps books and sheets, 5 exhibition cards, one paperstock sample, 7 business card samples, 8 record sleeves (2 for LPs, 2 for 10", and 4 for 7"), and 4 CD sleeves.
