ABSTRACT: James E. Lewis, Sr., collected this group of road maps of the United States and Canada in the middle to late 20th Century. The maps illustrate the changing landscape of the country, with the addition of the interstate highway system, and the ability of Americans to travel by automobile to visit far-off places.

This collection contains 82 folded road and street maps, from 27 states (Alabama, Arkansas, California, Florida, Georgia, Indiana, Iowa, Kentucky, Louisiana, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Montana, New Jersey, New Mexico, New York, North Carolina, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Virginia, West Virginia, and Wisconsin), 17 cities, Washington, D.C., and the Canadian province of Manitoba.
