ABSTRACT: This unprocessed collection of black-and-white photographs documents William Clay Ford's visit to Brussels, Belgium, and Expo 58 (Brussels World's Fair) in October 1958. Subjects include Ford's arrival at the Brussels airport; the Ford family; Ford's review of Expo exhibits and displays, meetings with officials, attendance at an awards ceremony; and displays of 1959 model year Ford automobiles. Photos are in form of 8x10 inch photographic prints, contact sheets, and negatives. See also related materials in William Clay Ford Records, 1913-1981, Accession 921.
